The first astronaut dog inspires a show that retells a fundamental chapter in the history of space travel with striking visual effects. Yet meanwhile it is a heartbreaking story of abuse.

It was in 1957 (for this tale is inspired by true events) that it happened – when the Soviet Union launched an animal into space for the first time. She would go down in history as the first living being to orbit the Earth. In this production, this wee puppy called Laika roams free in Moscow's parks and squares, never dreaming that her fate will take her to the very stars she sees at night. Because she herself will become a star – the star of a heartbreaking story that will carry her in the Sputnik II spacecraft to orbit our planet. Yet while this was an exciting adventure, Laika's story did not end happily – at least not for its star. So Xirriquiteula Teatre uses this outcome to tell a parallel story: one about those who, like Laika, are the victims of abuse; those who find themselves trapped – without asking to be – in the power struggles of others.



Laika is the culmination of a long and intense year of collective creation. Xirriquiteula has chosen to recount this moving tale without words, skilfully blending techniques as diverse as rear projection created live on stage, puppetry, automatons, voices off and the actors' own dramatic resources.

Laika is a theatrical proposal for all audiences, aiming to reach viewers worldwide. The show speaks to us of wonders up in the heavens but also of injustices here on Earth.
